KENSEI also went four wide into the first turn then stalked off the inside, bid three deep into the stretch then inside the winner, could not match that one in the final furlong and held second. HONOUR THE DEPUTY allowed to settle outside a rival then just off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well but missed the place. INDIAN FIREWATER stalked the pace off the rail then bid alongside a rival on the backstretch and into the second turn, tracked that one off the inside leaving that turn and weakened in the stretch. CIGAR MAN settled along the inside, came out on the second turn, split horses past the quarter pole, angled out into the stretch and was not a threat. MATTO MONDO (CHI) pulled his way to the early lead a bit off the rail then angled in and set the pace inside, inched away again leaving the
