YES I'M LUCKY vied inside for command, dueled on the turn, raced off the inside turning for home, battled with the winner and stayed on gamely to the end. RUN FOR LOGISTICS was off a bit slow, then had the rider lose the irons and drop back, recovered to move back into contention nearing the half mile pole, waited for room on the rail midway on the turn, made a bid on the rail entering the stretch and weakened. FOILEEN vied outside early, dueled between rivals on the turn and weakened.
