AL KHALI settled in good position for five furlongs, raced between horses along the backstretch, swung three wide while gaining at the quarter pole, charged to the front in midstretch and drew clear under good handling. EL CRESPO raced in hand along the rail to the turn, angled out in upper stretch then closed late while splitting horses to narrowly gain the place. ARMSTRONG MILL stumbled and bumped with RESERVOIR at the start, was unhurried for a half while saving ground, swung four wide while advancing on the turn, made a run to reach contention in upper stretch and closed late in the middle of the track to gain a share. RESERVOIR was taken in hand while angling out on the first turn, pressed the pace for seven furlongs, lodged a bid to challenge in upper stretch, battled inside the winner leaving the furlong marker and weakened late. SAL THE BARBER set the pace along the rail to the top of the stretch and weakened from his early efforts. UNCLE T SEVEN trailed along the inside to the turn and failed to mount a serious rally. BLANK CHECK stalked three wide to the turn and gave way.
