Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Apr), by Dynaformer - Speed Succeeds by Gone West. Trainer Albertrani Thomas. Bred by Live Oak Stud(FL).

BRILLIANT SPEED settled nicely into midpack in the two path before reaching the opening bend, rated kindly, within range throughout the initial six furlongs, was placed three wide midpoint on the second turn, in preparation for the stretch drive, spun from that path under strong encouragement, gained readily on the front runners during the ensuing furlong, left the eighth pole full of momentum and drove past the leader to take over soon afterwards, kicked clear under good handling. QUEEN'SPLATEKITTEN left in good order, and established control under her own power, was taken over to the inside, cut the pace, under a firm hold with CHINGLISH in close attendance along the outside, and LIVE IN JOY making some presence felt from the three path likewise, continued along on the same scenario until nearing the end of the run around the far turn, was asked for a response as the pressure from the closest pursuers intensified, inched away to increase his advantage, but with the winner full of run by this juncture bearing down, got overhauled when unable to match speed, but continued onward with good energy to garner place honors. KING CONGIE saved ground, angled out in the stretch and rallied to grab the show. SKY BLAZER got off slowly, after rearing up and striking the left side of the starting gate as the field was sent off and running, was placed under a firm hold and quickly taken over to the hedge, lagged behind at the back of the pack until nearing the quarter pole, was let out a notch entering the stretch, swung outward to the middle of the course for optimal racing clearance, now placed widest of all, coming to the eighth pole, came home with strong late foot to take the last major award. PERREGAUX tracked the front runners, while rating kindly slightly off the hedge, slithered into the two path leaving the five-sixteenths pole, turned into the stretch and was asked for a response, was taken in hand, when momentarily off another's heels just past the three-sixteenths pole, chose to alter course outward a little further down the road, finished fairly evenly thereafter. CHINGLISH forwardly placed almost from the get-go, offered some resistance on the bit before rating kindly on the opening bid, prompted the leader from the outside, issued a challenge coming to the quarter pole, kept up the pressure until the eighth pole before backing away. SEAL COVE underwent a three to four wide journey and had no rally. LIVE IN JOY stalked the leader from the three path around each bend, was in the process of making a run at the leader when he bore out badly entering the stretch. CLEMENT ROCK three wide on the far turn, tired. CANAVERAL (GB) between rivals for a good portion of the running, gave way.
