CAT TOUR sprinted clear in the early stages, raced uncontested on the lead to the turn and drew off to a lengthy score while being kept to the task. BLENIEM checked in tight at the start, raced just off the pace while saving ground to the turn and finished willingly to best the others. STORM IN MAY raced between horses along the backstretch, swung five wide approaching the stretch then closed late to gain a share. ELNINODEMISOJOS dropped well back on the first turn, was outrun while saving ground to the turn and failed to threaten while improving his position. DEFINITELY TRUE chased the leaders while three wide to the top of the stretch and steadily tired thereafter. BLUE SAILOR tracked the winner along the rail for six furlongs and gave way. SPARKLING NOTION drifted very wide on the first turn, angled in on the backstretch, saved ground to the turn and lacked a strong closing response. MELMONT was never a factor after racing wide in the early stages. POP GOES THE TIGER stumbled at the start and was never close thereafter.
