By subscription of \$75 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start - with \$55,000 guaranteed and an additional \$20,000 from the FTBOA Stakes Fund monies will be correspondingly divided provided a Florida Bred Registered with the FTBOA and/or by a sire registered with the FTBOA and or by a FSS nominated sire has finished in an awarded position. Any FTBOA Stakes fund monies not awarded will revert back to the fund. The Owner of the winner to receive 60%, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. MIDNIGHT SERENADE outrun early, swung wide for the stretch run, then closed with a rush to catch BURNING TIME just inside the eighth pole and drew clear. BURNING TIME stalked the pace, slipped through along the rail to gain a slim lead in the stretch, then bumped with SINGAPORE THUNDER and couldn't match strides with the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. EL ROMANO unhurried after hitting the gate hard at the start, raced four wide around the far turn, then steadied briefly in behind MIDNIGHT SERENADE in the stretch and gained the show. ANGELOFDISTINCTION rated off the pace, made a run five wide around the far turn to loom a threat, then gave way. SINGING MY WAY was tracking the pace when steadied in behind the leaders on the first turn, remained in contention to the top of the stretch, then tired. SINGAPORE THUNDER pressed the pace, moved to take over on the far turn, made the pace into the stretch, then was faltering when he bumped with BURNING TIME. REV IT UP saved ground and failed to menace. ISUTALKINTOME reserved after being steadied in the early going, advanced four wide around the far turn to reach the attending position, then had nothing left for the drive. SUPERIORITY steadied in behind rivals soon after entering the first turn, stalked the pace three wide to the top of the stretch, then dropped back. LORD CHELSIE set the pace under pressure along the rail into the far turn, then was fading when steadied from tight quarters leaving that turn.
