MISS BULLISTIC, up close early, advanced three deep leaving the turn, took the lead outside horses near the sixteenth pole then drove clear. UNHINDERED, forced in by CONCEALEDWITHAKISS after breaking slowly, was well back on the turn, swung very wide in upper stretch and closed strongly. COCO'S WILDCAT disputed the pace two wide, opened a clear lead near the eighth pole and weakened late. HARLAN'S HONOR, reluctant to load into the starting gate, broke alertly, hugged the rail, disputed the pace to mid stretch, gave way and drifted out late. CHARMING ENTRY saved ground on the turn, worked between horses in the stretch, failed to be a menace and steadied behind HARLAN'S HONOR in deep stretch. KAWFEE FA MARFA, no factor, raced between horses in the stretch and steadied in traffic near the sixteenth pole. SAINT EMMA'S FIRE saved ground on the turn, worked between rivals in the stretch and steadied in tight quarters near the sixteenth pole. MAJESTIC BLOOM raced in mid pack and failed to rally. MERCER MILL MAE chased the pace three wide and gave way in the drive. SHINING AMERICA was not a factor. PISTOLINA, wide turning for home, was not a factor. AWAKE THE DAY, steadied and rank in traffic entering the turn, gave way. CONCEALEDWITHAKISS bore in leaving the starting gate, chased the pace and faltered. An objection by the rider of CHARMONG ENTRY against HARLAN'S HONOR for alleged interference in deep stretch was not allowed.
