SENSATIONAL NIKKI stalked outside, bid three deep on the turn and led four wide into the stretch, kicked clear then drifted inward in midstretch and held sway under steady handling and stronger hand urging in the final stages. WIRED FOR FUN a bit slow to begin, went up inside to stalk the pace, steadied in tight off heels midway on the turn, got through along the rail into the stretch and finished willingly along the fence. HUGH KNEW broke in a bit, was outside a rival early then pulled her way between horses on the backstretch and was in tight and shuffled back a half mile out, was a bit green behind runners into the turn, came three deep into the stretch and bested the rest. DEBT FREE ABBY had good early speed and dueled outside a rival then between foes leaving the turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. SOAR HOME three deep early, stalked between horses then fell back toward the inside on the turn, angled in past midstretch and steadied in tight a sixteenth out along the rail. SPRING DREAM dueled inside, came out into the stretch, weakened then drifted in from the whip a sixteenth out.
