1 $\frac{1}{2}$ MILES. (Inner Turf) (2.10¹) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 *SHEEPSHEAD BAY S. (GRADE II) INNER TURF FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD.* No nomination fee. A supplemental nomination fee of \$1,500 may be made at time of entry. \$1,500 to pass the entry box. All starters to receive a \$1,000 rebate. All supplemental nominations will be required to pay the entry fee. The purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Any horse that competes in both the Sheepshead Bay and New York will have their entry fee waived for the New York. Three year olds, 117 lbs. Older 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 or a Grade 2 twice on the turf since October 1, 2009 allowed 3 lbs.; non-winners of \$90,000 in 2009-10, 5 lbs.; four races on the turf 7 lbs. (M aiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, May 8, 2010 with 21 Nominations. (Cloudy 70)

TREAT GENTLY (GB) was rated while stalking the pacesetter, kept a watchful eye on that rival for seven furlongs, ranged up when ready to issue her challenge for the lead, took over while holding something in reserve nearing the head of the stretch, had the rider take a quick peek back at the potential firing line gathered behind, after being straightened away, before being asked for a response, opened up a comfortable advantage during the run through the furlong grounds, then increased her winning margin from that point under intermittent encouragement. NEHANTIC KAT outran for a mile while taking the inside route, swung out turning for home and had a good rally to garner place honors. BUBBLY JANE (BRZ) was off a beat slow, after appearing to brush the right side of the starting gate, rode the rail around the first turn, slipped out to the two path midway down the backstretch, tipped out even wider on far turn before beginning her bid, set off the leader after entering the stretch, then finished willingly to be along for the show. THE GAILLIMH GIRL (IRE) contently tracked the front runner from the rail, angled outward, splitting rivals at the quarter pole, got outkicked during the final eighth. LIBERALLY (IRE) well placed for a mile, lacked the needed response after being called upon. BALLYNOE four wide around the far turn, had no rally. PARI took control in short order after leaving the gate, loped along on the lead towards the inside, offered no resistance once challenged and steadily tired thereafter.
