Closed with 67 To remain eligible the following payment must be made; \$800 on or before Friday, April 27, 2007. Closed with 31. All nominees to pay \$3,000 to enter and an additional \$3,000 to start with \$200,000 added and an additional \$100,000 from the Breeders' Cup fund for Cup nominees only. The host association's added money and all fees to be divided 60% to winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth and 2% to fifth. Breeders' Cup monies also correspondingly divided provided a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup monies not awarded will revert to the fund. Three-year-- olds 113 lbs. Older 124 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Breeders' Cup Limited shall also present a trophy to the winning owner. (Clear 76)

THE TIN MAN stalked the pace outside a rival, bid three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch, gained a short lead past the eighth pole and gamely prevailed under urging. GET FUNKY stalked the pace a bit off the rail, bid between horses on the second turn, put a head in front in upper stretch and continued willingly between foes to the wire. WILLOW O WISP sped to the early lead, angled in on the first turn and set the pace inside, dueled on the second turn, fought back along the fence in the stretch and also went on gamely to the end. BECRUX (ITY) chased inside then a bit off the rail, continued between horses into and on the second turn, came out for room in the stretch and finished with interest. RIGHT SPECIAL (BRZ) settled inside then outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, came three deep into the stretch and found his best stride late. KIP DEVILLE pulled his way along to stalk the pace inside, came out a bit into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CHINESE DRAGON angled in and chased inside, continued along the rail in the stretch and could not offer the needed late response. CHARMO (FR) saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. VEGA'S LORD (GER) chased outside a rival then three deep into and on the second turn and did not rally, then returned bleeding in the mouth. FAST AND FURIOUS (FR) off a bit slowly, pulled his way along outside a rival and steadied on the backstretch, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally.
