Bay Gelding, (Apr), by Choisir (AUS) - Leala (IRE) by Montjeu (IRE). Trainer Mitchell R. Mike. Bred by Miss Deidre Cogan (IRE).

OBVIOUSLY (IRE) had good early speed outside foes then angled in on the first turn, set the pace along the rail, responded when rivals loomed into the second turn, inched away again and won clear under left handed urging. ZA APPROVAL saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail into the second turn, angled out leaving that turn to enter the stretch three deep, drifted in a bit but continued willingly to be second best. WILKINSON sent between horses early then angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, inched forward into the second turn, came out a bit in the stretch then drifted in and held third. JERANIMO unhurried along the inside for six furlongs, moved up some along the rail leaving the second turn, came out in the stretch, went around a rival past midstretch and lacked the needed rally. LUCAYAN (FR) between horses early, stalked outside a rival, moved up nearing the second turn, was between horses into the stretch and weakened.
