SIDNEY'S CANDY sped between foes to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, came off the rail leaving the first turn, angled back in, responded when challenged on the backstretch, inched away on the second turn and drew clear through the drive under a brisk hand ride until the final stages. INDIAN FIREWATER stalked the winner off the rail, bid outside that one on the backstretch, continued off the inside on the second turn, came out some in the stretch and held second. NEXTDOORNEIGHBOR chased inside then off the fence, angled back to the rail in the drive and was edged for the place. STEPHEN'S GOT HOPE pulled his way along outside a rival then chased off the rail, angled in entering the stretch, came out past midstretch and lacked a rally. BLUE PANIS (FR) saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and alongside a rival into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response.
