1 3/8 MILES. (1,543) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 *SKIP AWAY S. (GRADE III) FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.* Free nomination by Saturday, March 19, 2011, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 Guaranteed. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. The Association's money to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry at a fee of \$5,000, which includes entry and starting fees. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes over a mile since July 1 allowed 2 lbs.; of \$45,000 twice over a mile since June 1 4 lbs., of two races other than maiden or claiming at a mile or over in 2011 6 lbs., Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to 14 Starters, with Also Eligibles. Should more than 14 entries pass the entry box, the starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners, then highest 2009-2011 earnings. The winning owner to receive a trophy. Closed Saturday, March 19, 2011 with 33 nominations. (Clear 82)

S. S. STONE prompted the pace outside COLIZEO, moved to gain a slim lead from that rival leaving the far turn, maintained that advantage to the sixteenth pole, then drew clear. JACKSON BEND stalked the pace three wide, was outmowed into the stretch, then responded to pressure and wore down COLIZEO to gain the place while unable to get to the winner. COLIZEO set the pace along the rail, responded when S. S. STONE moved to the fore leaving the far turn, stayed with that rival to the sixteenth pole, then gave way. RON THE GREEK outrun early, raced four wide around the far turn and passed tired rivals without threatening. DROSSELMAYER unhurried early, circled rivals four wide to loom a threat on the far turn, then tired. JARDIM (BRZ) rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and faltered. MOE MAN steadied from tight quarters soon after the start and failed to menace. GABRIEL'S HILL tracked the pace into the far turn, then faded. OUR DARK KNIGHT stalked the pace along the inside to midway of the far turn, then had nothing left. WINGEDLIE raced three wide and was done early. KING GHIDORAH was through after six furlongs.
