FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD WHICH HAVE NOT WON A GRADED SWEEPSTAKES IN 2014.* By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$1,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weights, three year olds, 120 lbs. Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstake in 2014 allowed 2 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming or starter in 2014, 4 lbs.; of one such race in 2011, 4, 6 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, August 23, 2014 with 23 Nominations. (Clear 79)

TOASTING three wide in pursuit in aim of the front, got placed to encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch, rallied to seize command a furlong from home, inched away ridden out to the wire. KATIE'S GARDEN attended the pace three to four wide, took closer order on the leader through the turn, continued three wide for home and was roused at the three-sixteenths, was in the midst of seizing command from MONTANA NATIVE when displaced in tandem with that foe by the eventual winner at the eighth pole, kept on for the place honors not offering enough to match strides late with the aforementioned foe. MONTANA NATIVE broke out at the start and was coaxed to establish the front just off the inside while attended to the outside, had that rival steadily take closer order and intensify the pressure through the turn, got roused straightened for home at the three-sixteenths, dug in under challenge and was headed just outside the eighth pole then weakened in the late stages to the line. TAHOE TIGRESS tracked the pace along the inside in range of the front, came under a ride three furlongs out, spun three wide into upper stretch, offered no response. SISTER FRIEND just off the pace between foes just off the inside, came under coaxing at the half mile pole, dropped back through the turn and made no impact.
