REGAL CONQUEROR broke outward then ,moved quickly to the lead, set a pressured pace, drew clear late turn and widened,when lightly asked and continued on her own. PISCO stalked the pace, chased late turn then finished determinedly along the rail. SWEET BREW stalked the pace, chased late turn and finished gamely. WHY THE RING broke inward, settled off the pace, angled out from the rail to four-wide on the turn and rallied in vain. DIAMONDS ARE B F F, in touch, was shuffled back near the turn, angled out to the fifth path and chased into the stretch but failed to menace. OLYMPIC TALENT stalked early, closed up and pressed the leader on the turn, chased into the stretch but tired in the final furlong. ZINA STREET settled off the pace, was hustled between foes on the turn but never reached contention. RING FOR ROSY, away slowly, settled off the pace, was hustled three to six-wide through the turn then evened out in the late stages. TURN THE PAGE raced off the pace, chased four and five-wide on the turn but evened out in the final 16th. DELRAY MOON settled in midpack, was hustled along the rail on the turn but had no response in the stretch. TINY DONUTS, off slowly, trailed the field and lacked a serious closing response.

KATHERINE'S WAR forced the issue early, chased from the rail on the turn then tired in the stretch.
