pressured the leader off the inside, moved to put a head in front between horses and inside the winner in the second turn, narrowly showed the way into the lane and past the furlong marker, outkicked by the winner late, narrowly held the place. ALWAYS IN A TIZ in the second flight while just off the inside, in some traffic in the second turn, steered out to be three wide turning for home, set down for the drive, coming late while widest of the first flight at the wire. STORMY HOLIDAY fell far back after the start, continued to trail backstretch, swung out to be six wide when beginning to move out of the final turn, continued to show interest to the wire while not a serious threat to the top three. BROWN ALMIGHTY four wide through the first turn when off the pace, continued off the pace and the inside, came up empty for the drive. OFFICER

ALEX off a step slow, raced back, advanced, closest four wide with a quarter remaining, had little left in the late going. AVARE away alertly, set the pace along the inside, offered little resistance when headed in the far turn, continued to fade stretch. BEST OF BIRDSTONE never

threatened while racing just off the inside. KING HENNY four wide into the first turn, began a steady fade after a half.
