BOLD CHIEFTAIN chased between horses then outside a rival on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch, steadied when boxed in off heels in midstretch, continued in tight in traffic past the eighth pole, split rivals with a bid to gain the lead in deep stretch and gamely held under some late urging. PALLADIO chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well. UNUSUAL SMOKE chased three deep then off the rail, continued outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished willingly to edge rivals for third. JERANIMO chased inside, came out off heels when lacking room in midstretch and again past the eighth pole and continued on well to just miss the show. ACCLAMATION four wide into the first turn, stalked off the rail, bid three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch, gained a short lead past the eighth pole, was between horses in deep stretch and was outfinished. ENRICHED took the early lead and angled in, dueled inside, fought back in the stretch and weakened some late. WICKED STYLE three deep between horses early, angled in and stalked a bit off the rail on the backstretch and second turn, awaited room off heels in midstretch then continued along the fence late. UNUSUAL SUSPECT saved ground off the pace to the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. THE USUAL Q. T. pulled his way between horses then prompted the pace outside a rival, was between foes again in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong.
