CARACORTADO broke in a bit, was between horses early, chased just off the rail then outside a rival on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up in midstretch, gained the lead under urging a sixteenth out and gamely prevailed. THE USUAL Q. T. a step slow into stride, stalked three deep then outside a foe, took the lead outside the pacesetter in upper stretch, drifted in some but fought back inside the winner through the final furlong and continued willingly to the end. SOUL CANDY broke a bit slowly and was squeezed back, settled inside then outside a rival on the backstretch, moved up leaving the second turn, swung out into the stretch and gained the show. JERANIMO saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PRESIOUS PASSION veered out at the start, took the lead outside foes then set the pace off the rail, angled in on the second turn, fought back some in upper stretch but weakened in the final furlong. MOBILIZED between horses early, settled off the pace inside, came out in upper stretch and did not rally. NO INFLATION also between foes early, stalked a bit off the rail then inside to the stretch and weakened. PICKAPOCKET chased inside then came out leaving the first turn, continued off the inside on the backstretch and second turn and did not rally.
