(GRADE III) THREE YEAR OLDS.* By subscription of \$300 on Friday, February 11, 2011 at \$300 for The Southwest, The Rebel and The Arkansas Derby. \$2,000 to pass the entry box and \$2,000 additional to start, with \$250,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the Owner of the win ner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally between remaining starters. WEIGHTS: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$40,000 at a mile or over in 2011, allowed 3 lbs.; \$30,000 at a mile or over at any time allowed 5 lb s.; \$25,000 at any distance, allowed 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered). In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings, excluding money won in restricted races. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Closed Friday, February 11, 2011 with one hundred seven (107) nominees. Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Mar), by Arch - Woodman's Dancer by Woodman. Trainer Fires H. William. Bred by Grapestock LLC(KY). ARCHARCHARCH four wide and in some traffic into the first turn, stalked four wide up the backstretch and into the far turn, challenged five wide into the lane, clear, kept to task, drifted in late. J P'S GUSTO settled three wide and off the pace, brief wait in traffic late in the final turn, got through, set down, no match winner, bothered late after the issue had been decided. ELITE ALEX last away, five wide into and through much of the first turn, continued outside and back, ranged up, fanned six wide into the lane, managed a mild rally to finish best of the others. PICKO'S PRIDE forced out at the start, sluggish to begin, made a nice gain along the inside second turn, blocked into the lane, switched out, finished willingly. YANKEE PASSION carried wide into the first turn, continued outside in the second turn, moved a bit closer while well out in the strip late in the second turn, flattened out a bit in the drive to finish up evenly. CALEB'S POSSE lacked speed, edged closer in traffic midway on the second turn, lacked room soon after, continued to have no where to run into the lane, altered course to the outside late, improved a bit after the issue had been decided. GRANT JACK prompted the pace three wide, challenged three wide through the second turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. DERIVATIVE narrowly set the early pace toward the inside, briefly got clear the middle half, faltered when headed turning for home. BRICKYARD FAST pressured the leader, vied between foes into the far turn, also gave way in the drive. GHOST IS CLEAR was finished early. BONAROO was done after a half.
