SWEET REASON drifted out entering the main track while under urging, raced near the outside of the field while ridden along, advanced

five wide early on the turn, took the lead while four wide late on the bend, kicked clear into the stretch, was given one tap of a down-turned

whip outside the eighth-pole then drew off while ridden out in a dominant performance. STOPCHARGINGMARIA was urged along while just off the pace, raced in the two path early on the turn, came under stronger urging while directly behind the pacesetter at the five-sixteenths, shifted

three wide at that point, swung five wide into the stretch and proved no match for the winner while clearly second best. DANCING HOUSE moved in early then settled off the pace, raced inside on the turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths, swung four wide into the stretch, drifted

in under a left-handed whip outside the furlong marker and safely secured the show. SWEET WHISKEY was forwardly placed on the outside, chased four wide early on the turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, dropped to three wide late on the bend, drifted in under pressure

in upper stretch and tired. DESIGNER LEGS was urged along at the rear of the field, raced off the rail early on the turn, angled four wide in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, continued four wide while under a drive into the stretch and failed to threaten. BAHNAH came out at the start

but broke in front, was one of several rivals showing speed, moved to the lead, edged clear inside the five-eighths pole, raced two to three wide on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths, lost the advantage outside the quarter-pole and faded. TRUE BLUE NATION showed speed for the opening quarter-mile then dropped back quickly, went four to five wide on the turn and retreated. ART OF THE GAME showed speed then chased the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, went three wide on the turn and stopped. BRAZEN PERSUASION stuck her feet in the ground at the break, absolutely refused the start despite several attempts by the rider to get her to leave then was walked off.
