Bay Gelding, (May), by Read the Footnotes - Near Bethany by Affirmed. Trainer Brown C. Chad. Bred by Howard Nolan Jr.(NY). READTHEPROSPECTUS got leaned upon by NIGHT MANEUVER for a couple of jumps after the start, settled at or very near the back of the pack as the field proceeded down the backstretch, was in the two path and between foes when let out a notch at the half mile pole, picked up interest and ranged up towards the front runners during the ensuing quarter, was still unasked for a serious response gradually fanning outward nearing the head of the lane, was in the four path when the drive home began, got called upon for more, drifted out several lanes wider under steady left handed pressure, gained ground readily in the final furlong not being fed as much stick work as before, was outside a pair in the late stages, outfinished them to grab away the decision, crossing the wire being primarily hand urged. SPA CITY FEVER involved with the pace during the opening stages, got eased back into more of a stalking role, crept into a contending position while travelling three wide on the bend, was given his cue spinning into the stretch, was in between rivals, although with some space separating them all, for most of the final sixteenth, held on in a willing manner to secure second. NIGHT MANEUVER came out a bit after the start, making sustained light contact with the winner as a result, moved up to assume a forward position, sparred heads apart with ABILIO during the run around the bend, with the runner up keeping watch within range parked out in the three path, had that one challenge for command turning for home, was being pressed by each of the top twosome while relinquishing inside the sixteenth pole, eventually weakening into the show slot. MOST HAPPY FELLA hard to load, departed the backstretch four wide, was under strong handling by its midpoint on the turn, entered the stretch and had no offering. BIGGER IS BETTOR fidgety with his head, got away two beats slowly, raced three wide on the turn, failed to pick up interest when asked to at the half mile pole. ABILIO dueled for command from the two path and gave way.
