REIGNING CATFISH broke outwards brushing SMOKIN GLOCK, was reserved along the inside tracking well off the second flight in the opening half, steadily gathered momentum on the turn while switching off the inside, swung four wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a steady late bid to wrest command in time under firm right handed encouragement. MASSIVE EXPLOSION was hustled to the lead along the inside racing into the turn, dictated the pace on a clear margin past midstretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner late. LASSELL, urged to gain a forward placing, angled inwards while leading the second flight between foes from just out of striking distance racing into the bend and continued willingly to late stages to close the gap while not quite matching terms with the top pair. FEAR THE KITTEN settled outside foes in the last flight in the opening half, was urged to advance three deep between foes racing through the turn, angled out five wide in upper stretch and made some belated progress to close the gap. ULTIMO TRAGO tracked off the second flight five wide in the opening stages, shifted in entering the bend to advance between foes, split rivals three deep racing into upper stretch to gain contention but was outkicked in the closing stages. PURGING THE STONE broke slowly, settled in the last flight along the rail, saved ground on the turn, then shifted just off the inside to improve position between foes late. SMOKIN GLOCK, brushed at the start, was righted to track the pacesetter inside foes in the second flight racing into the turn but had no closing response entering the lane. FLATHEAD RIVER tracked off the second flight three deep racing into the turn and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. SIR BOB tracked the pacesetter three deep in the second flight early and steadily retreated after a half. LAHSHAD was settled outside foes off the second flight, angled to the inside entering the turn and
