7 FURLONGS. (1.203) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 *STONERSIDE S.* (PLUS UP TO \$13,500 Open ATB) FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. No nomination fee. \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start with \$100,000 guaranteed of which \$60,000 to the owner of the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$11,000 to third, \$6,000 to fourth and \$3,000 to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 twice in 2006 allowed 3 lbs.; \$30,000 in 2006, 5 lbs.; \$30,000 in 2005-2006, 7 lbs. Maiden and claiming races not considered in allowances. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred. Total earnings will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to fourteen starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Wednesday, May 17, 2006 with 35 nominations.

Chestnut Filly, (Apr), by Forest Wildcat - Stylish Society by Forty Niner. Trainer Von Hemel K. Donnie. Bred by Pin Oak Stud, LLC(KY).

BROWNIE POINTS lacked early speed, raced just off the rail on the turn, steadied while blocked at the top of the stretch, rallied along the rail entering the final furlong and closed strongly to get up late. SWEET IDEA was urged along on the inside, saved ground on the turn, angled out near the three-sixteenths pole, surged to the lead passing the furlong marker, edged clear inside that marker but was caught late in a good effort. KALYRRA was allowed to settle into stride, raced three wide on the turn, shifted six wide near the quarter-pole, dropped to five wide entering the stretch and was along for the show. TRICK'S PIC settled towards the rear of the field, raced three wide on the turn, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and failed to rally. ANNIE SAVOY was ridden along on the outside, shifted in leaving the backstretch, raced off the rail on the turn, steadied briefly outside the quarter-pole and came up empty. OPEN MEADOWS contested the pace on the inside of rivals while off the rail, edged clear while off the rail on the turn, lost the lead entering the final furlong and gave way. BEHOLDEN was urged along near the middle of the field, raced off the rail on the turn, dropped to the rail near the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. DANCING DELILAH was void of speed, swung five wide into the stretch and never reached contention. WHITE SHE DEVIL was well placed just behind the dueling leaders, moved off the rail approaching the quarter-pole and faded. PRAHTheta contested the pace between horses, chased three wide on the turn and stopped. PRINCESS PATRICIA contested the pace on the outside, chased four wide on the turn, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole, floated six wide into the stretch and faltered.
