STOPSHOPPINGMARIA away in good order, quickly established control, sat entrenched in the two path while setting the splits, had the rider cast a glance back at the competition coming to the five-sixteenths pole, began to edge away shortly afterwards and was asked for a response, emerged from the furlong grounds with a comfortable advantage, increased the winning margin in the last eighth, crossing the wire under brisk hand encouragement. BOOK REVIEW skittish during the loading procedure, came in at the start, making contact with the nearest rival, recovered and took up the chase from the two path, had the rider look back several times prior to be guided over to the inside during the run around the bend, made the maneuver at the five-sixteenths pole, taking away position from BE WITH ME but not before making the rider of that opponent steady, made her bid, already being roused, coming to the quarter pole, proved no match for the winner, but held the place. DELIGHTFUL MAGIC stumbled at the start, bounced back up and took up the chase on the pacesetter from the three path, began to lose contact nearing the end of the turn, got out finished during the stretch drive and had to settle for the show. CENTRIQUE under some hand encouragement from the get-go, closed the gap steadily while saving ground throughout, made progress until the eighth pole, before flattening out. HEARTS OF RED underwent a three wide pursuit and folded. TERRALBA four wide departing the backstretch, made no serious bids. BE WITH ME settled along the inside soon after the start, was already being urged along well before reaching the end of the backstretch, was taken in hand off heels coming to the five-sixteenths pole, as the runner up crossed over with little room to spare, tired after entering the lane. CERTAINTY was bumped and forced inward at the start, got outrun for nearly a half, attempted to rally six wide at the head of the stretch, the
