I GOT IT ALL raced five, then four wide early while being rated off the second flight in the opening half, commenced a steady four wide advance on the turn to challenge the pacesetter racing into upper stretch, shifted inwards under pressure while gaining the advantage then kicked clear under firm right handed pressure. STORMY PACIFIC tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, came around a tiring foe to gain position racing into upper stretch, switched out three deep entering the lane and continued with interest to prove best of the others. GOOD BYE GREG broke inwards bumping BOURBONIZE, was righted while moving away to a clear advantage, shifted to the inside racing into the bend, set the pace to upper stretch and weakened once headed by the winner. MCQ ducked a bit at the start, was prompted to gain a position tracking the pacesetter as part of the second flight racing to the turn, was urged between foes in pursuit of the leader nearing upper stretch but lacked a closing response.
