1 MILE. (1.33<sup>2</sup>) STAKES. Purse \$65,000 *STRAIGHT LINE S. FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS*. Nominations close Friday August 8, 2014, with no fee. A Supplementary Nomination of \$500 may be made on Wednesday, August 13, 2014, which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$100 to pass the entry box and an additional \$100 to start, with \$65,000 Added; after payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. WEIGHT: 12 2 lbs. Non winners of \$50,000 in 2014, allowed 3 lbs.; \$35,000 once or \$20,000 twice in 2014, allowed 5 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered.) This event will be limited to twelve (12) starters. Highweights preferred. Preference of horses of equal weight will be Highest Total Earnings in 2014. Failure to draw into this race at time of entry cancels all fees. Starters to be named through the entry box at usual time of closing. Two (2) horses having common ties through ownership cannot start at the exclusion of a single ownership interest. Trophy to the owner of the winner. Nominations Closed Friday, August 8, 2014 with 23. (Cloudy 81)

I GOT IT ALL raced five, then four wide early while being rated off the second flight in the opening half, commenced a steady four wide advance on the turn to challenge the pacesetter racing into upper stretch, shifted inwards under pressure while gaining the advantage then kicked clear under firm right handed pressure. STORMY PACIFIC tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, came around a tiring foe to gain position racing into upper stretch, switched out three deep entering the lane and continued with interest to prove best of the others. GOOD BYE GREG broke inwards bumping BOURBONIZE, was righted while moving away to a clear advantage, shifted to the inside racing into the bend, set the pace to upper stretch and weakened once headed by the winner. MCQ ducked a bit at the start, was prompted to gain a position tracking the pacesetter as part of the second flight racing to the turn, was urged between foes in pursuit of the leader nearing upper stretch but lacked a closing response. SULTRY CAT stumbled, then was bumped by BOURBONIZE at the start while being forced into a rival's path, settled between foes in the last flight racing to the turn, swung out five wide racing into upper stretch and was making mild progress late. PUPPY MANNERS, bumped by SULTRY CAT just after the start, settled in the last flight along the inside and continued evenly inside foes to the lane. MR THUNDER BOY broke a bit slowly, was settled into stride outside foes early and proved no threat. SOLITARY RANGER tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight in the opening stages, was prompted to lodge a brief bid between foes racing into the turn but soon flattened out. BOURBONIZE, bumped, then forced into a rival at start, raced in some close quarters early and never mounted a serious threat. BLICHTON, urged to gain a position inside rivals in the second flight in the opening half, retreated early.
