1 1/4 MILES. (1.471) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 *STYMIE S. INNER DIRT FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD*. No nomination fee. \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. A supplemental nomination of \$2,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Three year olds, 116 lbs. Older 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 since November 1, 2013 allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstakes in 2013-2014 or \$45,000 since August 1, 2013 allowed 4 lbs.; four races, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, February 1, 2014 with 21 Nominations. (Clear 47)

FARHAAN squeezed lightly between foes who each broke his way at the start, settled three to four wide in pursuit rated early on as a pair slipped away in hand through the early stages, got given some rein to work with and ranged up to challenge nearing the seven-sixteenths, poked a nostril in front three furlongs out, remained unasked while his nearest threat came under urging inside at the five-sixteenths, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch roused for the drive, battled head to head with PERCUSSION trading minor jostles mostly the function of his main rival trying to create more room as he held his path and ground, dug in gamely to repulse his main foe to the wire. PERCUSSION gap dueled in hand from the two path early on, got joined outside by the aforementioned rival at the seven-sixteenths as MAIL back out inside, got headed for command three furlongs out, came under encouragement nearing the five-sixteenths, cut the corner on nearly even terms with FARHAAN into the stretch, came under near sided stick work while down inside his main foe fighting head to head determined through the stretch, traded light bumps through to the wire but was ultimately repulsed on the line. JONESY BOY bumped lightly by PERCUSSION who broke in at the start, then was squeezed lightly between foes, raced unhurried two to three wide early on in pursuit from afar, made progress through the far turn urged from the five-sixteenths, kicked on belatedly to garner the show making up ground late on the embattled pair up top. MAIL broke in at the start squeezing back FARHAAN in tandem with GOURMET DINNER who broke outwards, dueled inside of PERCUSSION while in hand spurting away in tandem early on, came under coaxing at the half mile pole, began to fade nearing the midway point on the far turn and weakened in the stretch. GOURMET DINNER broke out at the start squeezing FARHAAN out lightly in tandem with MAIL, saved ground at the rear, came under encouragement three furlongs from home, swung three to four wide into upper stretch and made no impact.
