GRAND ADVENTURE, in range two-wide, closed late turn, launched his drive seven-wide at the top of the stretch, gained the lead midstretch, his rider lost his whip in the final furlong but prevailed under a strong drive. SKIPADATE raced off the pace, closed two-wide leaving the turn, led upper stretch, was headed but finished determinedly. STAR OF DAVID forced the pace on the backstretch, stalked on the turn, bid at the top of the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. UTTERLY COOL, in range, closed three-wide late turn, bid six-wide at the top of the stretch but evened out quickly. FREYGA raced off the pace, was hustled five then six-wide late turn then lacked a strong closing response. WIN AND REIGN was prominent from the outset, set a pressured pace, moved clear on the turn, drifted out four-wide at the top of the stretch then tired. PERFECT SHOWER, well back early, was hustled late turn but lacked a rally. JESS NOT JESSE, always close, bid five-wide at the top of the stretch, failed to stay and was steadied, then tired in the final furlong.
