PRAYER FOR RELIEF away well, showed the way past the wire the first time well reserved, got by with some pedestrian fractions while still in hand, asked when confronted nearing the furlong grounds, drew clear again late under continued steady handling. AWESOME BET well back early, moved a bit closer after a half, ranged up four wide late in the second turn, challenged briefly between foes a furlong out, could not match the winner late, gained the nod for the place. POPULIST POLITICS void of early foot, continued to trail into the far turn, swept up toward the front with a bold move while five wide late in that bend outside the runner up, lodged a brief bid in midstretch then could not keep up with the winner, outnodded for the place. ALTERNATION off a step slow, recovered to move up and race mid pack, in traffic behind a wall of horses late in the second turn, improved position when clear for the drive while not a serious threat to the top three. MR. WOODROW a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, broke in good order, prompted the pace three path, lacked a closing kick when asked in the drive. MALIBU GLOW off a bit slow, well back early, raced in hand and off the inside, roused late in the second turn, little in the way of a response. TRUBS closest to the winner through those soft fractions, had little left for the drive. MEISTERSINGER within striking distance for six furlongs along the inside, gave way in the drive. G. W.'S D'ORO saved ground to no avail.
