7 FURLONGS. (1.214) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 *FLORIDA STALLION SUSAN'S GIRL S. FOR FILLIES, TWO YEARS OLD (FOALS OF 2004)*. By subscription of \$2,500 each (Stallion) ; \$2,500 to pass the entry box and \$2,500 additional to start in September. The added money together with all nomination fees, eligibility payments, entry and starting fees to be divided - Approximately 12.5% of gross purse August 5 after distribution of Stallion Nominator and Breeders' Awards; Approximately 20.5% of gross purse September 2 after distribution of Stallion Nominator and Breeders' Awards; Approximately 66.5% of gross purse October 14 after distribution of Stallion Nominator and Breeders' Awards. Purses to be divided 60% to first, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Stallion and Breeders' Awards to be distributed according to Florida Statute in effect on the date of the race. Weight: 118 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner. Nominations for Stallions closed on February 15, 2003 with 137 Stallion Nominations. (No Supplementary Nominations). Closed Friday, May 12, 2006 with (851) nominations.

ADHRHYTHM settled just off the early pace, moved up from outside to challenge on the turn, took command in upper stretch and drew off to a lengthy score while being kept to the task. SILKILY stumbled and was bumped at the start, was unhurried for a half, split horses on the turn then closed late to best the others. SNOW LADY was outrun for a half, circled six wide into the stretch and rallied belatedly. SYNERGY checked in tight at the start, was unhurried for a half, rallied three wide to reach contention in upper stretch and flattened out. UNBRIDLED AMBIANCE set or forced the pace from outside for a half and gave way in the stretch. GRAEME CENTRAL dueled along the rail to the turn and faltered. PERFECT LIE checked after veering in at the start, raced up close for a half and faded in the stretch.
