7 FURLONGS. (1.214) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 *FLORIDA STALLION SUSAN'S GIRL S. FOR FILLIES, TWO YEARS OLD.* By subscription of \$2,500 each (Stallion) ; \$2,500 to pass the entry box and an addition \$2,500 to start . The added money together with all nomination fees, eligibility payments, entry and starting fees to be divided - Approx imately 12.5% of gross purse August 8 after distribution of Stallion Nominator and Breeders' Awards; Approximately 20.5% of gross purse August 29 after distribution of Stallion Nominator and Breeders' Awards; Approximately 66.5% of gross purse October 17a fter distribution of Stallion Nominator and Breeders' Awards. Purse to be divided 60% to first, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Stallion and Breeders' Awards to be distributed according to Florida Statute in effect on the datee of the race. Weight: 118 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner. Nominations for Stallions closed on February 15, 2006 with 140 Stallion Nominations. (No Supplementary Nominations). All fees must be paid prior to the race. Closed Monday, June 15, 2009 with 750 nominations. (Cloudy 84)

ROSEBUD'S RIDGE showed speed off the rail, increased her advantage in early stretch, then was fully extended to last over SWEETLALABYE while drifting out. The latter, rated off the pace, steadied on the backstretch, then lugged in along the rail through the stretch while rallying to just miss catching the winner. WINSOCKIE reserved early, raced three wide around the turn and closed ground late to gain the show. TILLIE THE TIGRESS tracked the pace into the stretch and tired. ALL DRAMA well placed early, saved ground around the turn and faltered. JOANIE'S CATCH dwelt badly at the start and was never a factor. MYAKKA CITY chased the winner into the stretch, then faded. There was a stewards inquiry into the incident at the start.
