CHEROKEE QUEEN stalked the pace along the inside, eased out and rallied to catch PERSUADING at the eighth pole, then drew clear under urging. NEVER RETREAT allowed to settle, raced three wide around the far turn, then rallied to be up for the place. PERSUADING set the pace along the rail into the stretch, then weakened. IT'S TEA TIME was caught in tight in the early going, saved ground while advancing into the stretch but had no further response. MUSICAL RAIN (IRE) unhurried after being steadied to avoid running up on DEPUTY DARLING in the early going, improved her position in the drive without threatening. MISS BLAKELY stalked the pace into the stretch and gave way. DEPUTY DARLING failed to menace. PROJECT ROSE well placed after being steadied racing into the first turn, saved ground around the far turn and tired. TRIX IN THE CITY tracked the pace into the far turn and faltered. MISS WORLD was through after six furlongs.
