7 FURLONGS. (1.21) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 *SWALE S. (GRADE II) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS.* By subscription of \$150 each by Saturday, March 14, 2009, which shall accompany the nomination, \$1,500 to pass the entry box and \$1,500 additional to start, with \$150,000 Guaranteed. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. The owner of the winner to receive \$90,000; \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth and \$3,000 to sixth. Supplemental nominations may be made on Wednesday, March 25, 2009 at a fee of \$6,000, which includes entry and starting fees. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a grade/group I or II stakes, allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstakes, 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs.; of a race other than maiden or claiming 8 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with Also Eligibles. High Weights Preferred with second preference to horses with the highest lifetime earnings. Trophy to the winning owner. Nominations closed Saturday, March 14, 2009 with 16 nominations. (Cloudy 80)

BIG DRAMA showed speed off the rail, responded when challenged by THIS ONES FOR PHIL racing into the stretch, came out to bump that rival at the sixteenth pole, then came out to bump that one soundly again nearing the wire and prevailed. THIS ONES FOR PHIL chased the pace three wide, made a run to try BIG DRAMA leaving the turn, was bumped by that rival at the sixteenth pole, then was bumped again by that one in the closing strides and edged to the wire. CUSTOM FOR CARLOS showed speed away from the gate, was steadied when he tried to duck in leaving the chute, steadied again from inside BIG DRAMA on the backstretch, continued to chase the pace along the rail into the turn, angled out for the drive and tired. BRAVE VICTORY failed to menace. SABI SABI tracked the leaders four wide around the turn and faltered. B Z WARRIOR was outrun. Following a stewards inquiry, BIG DRAMA was disqualified and placed second for interference to THIS ONES FOR PHIL in the stretch.
