REVVED UP, in hand early while following the leaders four wide, was asked a bit earlier because of slow fractions, moved to the fore in the upper stretch, then drove clear under steady encouragement. RUSH BAY, well placed in behind the leaders early, moved five wide on the far turn, loomed prominently outside the winner for the final furlong but wasn't good enough. ALWAYS FIRST (GB), unhurried early, raced five wide around the far turn and into the stretch and managed a mild gain. BIG PRAIRIE, within easy striking distance and racing near the inside to the stretch, worked his way out five wide nearing the final furlong and offered a slight gain. RAMAZUTTI went up early to track front-running LORD CARMEN three or four wide, reached the front nearing the final quarter but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. LOUVE ROYALE (IRE), taken in hand early, was outrun to the stretch, improved position with a minor late run while four wide. PORFIDO (CHI) raced within easy striking distance two or three wide into the upper stretch and flattened out. ROCHESTER, outrun to the stretch, swung out nine wide for the drive but never fired. LORD CARMEN gained the lead near the inside early, accomplished slow fractions for about ten furlongs and tired. SINGLE MON failed to menace.
