(GRADE III) FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination, \$500 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start with \$150,000 Guaranteed, with 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. Weight; 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or II at one mile or over on the turf, 2 lbs.; a Grade III or \$55,000 twice at one mile or over on the turf, 4 lbs.; two races other than maiden, claiming or starter at one mile or over on the turf since September 6, 2013, 6 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in estimating weight allowances.) This field will be limited to twelve starters. In the event more than twelve pass through the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined at that time with preference given to Grade I, II or III Stakes winners in that order, then those that have accumulated the highest turf earnings in 2013-14. For those that enter and are eliminated under these conditions, the nomination and entry fees will be refunded. SUPPLEMENTARY NOMINATIONS OF \$3000 EACH (which include entry and starting fees) NOMINATIONS CLOSED SATURDAY, JANUARY 18, 2014 WITH 33. (Clear 71)

GUYS REWARD raced off the pace, advanced inside passing the quarter pole, angled off the rail, launched a strong rally outside and ran down SALTO in deep stretch. SALTO (IRE) stalked the leaders, bid three wide on the far turn, rallied to a clear lead in midstretch and then could not go with the winner. GOLDEN SABRE raced off the pace, moved up approaching the stretch, angled out and finished well outside. RIDING THE RIVER raced off the pace inside, between foes into the stretch and gained mildly. DANNHAUSER raced three wide early, then pressed the pace, bid between rivals on the turn and weakened. MELLOW FELLOW set the pace, dueled on the far turn and weakened. LOOKING COOL raced off the rail and failed to rally. SUPER CHUNKY did not factor. NICKLAUS WAY raced three wide and faded.
