Purse \$350,000 **TAMPA BAY DERBY (GRADE II) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS.** By subscription of \$150 each which should accompany the nomination, \$1,250 to pass the entry box and \$1,750 additional to start with \$350,000 Guaranteed, with 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I at one mile or over, 2 lbs.; \$60,000 or a Grade II at one mile or over, 4 lbs.; three races other maiden, claiming or starter, 6 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in estimating g weight allowances). Starters and riders to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This field will be limited to twelve starters. In the event more than twelve pass through the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined with preference given to Grade I, II or III Stakes winners in that order, then those that have accumulated the highest career earnings. For those that enter and are eliminated under these conditions, the nomination and entry fees will be refunded. **SUPPLEMENTARY NOMINATIONS OF \$7,500 EACH** (which include the entry and starting fees) **CLOSE WEDNESDAY, MARCH 9, 2011 BY THE USUAL TIME OF CLOSING. CLOSED SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 26, 2011 WITH 38 NOMINATIONS.** (Clear 65)

WATCH ME GO raced well placed, ranged up three wide in the second turn, continued outside the top two while challenging into the stretch then responded to strong handling to outgame CRIMSON KNIGHT through the late stages. CRIMSON KNIGHT chased the leader early, bid outside after five furlongs, gained a short lead a furlong out then also continued gamely to the wire before just missing. BRETHREN pressed the pace early, gained a clear lead before a half, resisted when challenged past mid stretch then angled outside the top two once passed but gave way late. BEAMER void of early speed, made up some ground late with a mild rally. ECONOMIC SUMMIT passed tiring rivals. FREE ENTRY was well placed after six furlongs but had no rally. TOO EXPERIENCE made a middle move to the stretch then came up empty. STRIDING AHEAD was no factor. MOONHANGER flipped in the gate, rushed to the front early then stopped.
