JUSGIMMETENMINUTES was slow early, eased out in the upper stretch, closed through traffic and got up in the final strides. TROPIC VISION stalked the pace, challenged four wide on the turn, dueled past the eighth pole, inched clear and was caught late. MINSTREL MAN DAN raced mid pack, bid willingly, didn't have enough late. TALKITY TALK vied inside, faltered near the sixteenth pole and dropped back. NOW WE'RE COOKING was away alertly, vied two across to mid stretch and gave way. RUN HUCKLEBERRY was not a factor. SANDHILL MINSTREL stalked inside, bid along the rail on the turn and came up empty. STRATTON was reluctant to load and was outrun in an even effort. SEVERE STORM was steadied at the start, trailed the field and showed little.
