1 MILE. (1.32²) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 *TEMPTED S. (GRADE III)* FOR FILLIES TWO YEARS OLD. No nomination fee. A supplemental nomination fee of \$1,000 may be made by closing time of entries. \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start, with \$100,000 added. All starters including supplements will be required to pay entry and starting fees. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 121 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 allowed 2 lbs.; two races, 4 lbs.; a race, 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, October 24, 2009 with 28 Nominations. (Clear 52)

AILALEA rode the rail until slipping outward to the three path midway on the turn, ranged up to the leader after being asked for a response, overtook the tiring pacesetter approaching the furlong marker, then maintained a safe margin under a drive. MAMBO FEVER within striking distance, was guided over to the inside during the run around the bend, advanced steadily into contention, angled to the outside midstretch, made up a bit of ground during the final furlong, but had to settle for being a clear second. NONNA MIA bobbed at the break, established command soon after the start, cut the fractions while racing towards the inside, gave way readily midstretch. TIZAHIT ducked out a bit at the start, failed to reach a contending position. KITTY IN A TIZZY had a wide journey and faded after going a half. WORSTCASESCENARIO chased the leader for nearly six furlongs before folding.
