Bay Gelding, (Mar), by Strong Contender - My Twilight Dancer by Twilight Agenda. Trainer Amoss M. Thomas. Bred by Epona Thoroughbreds(KY).

GRAND CONTENDER went two then three wide on the first turn, settled in the second flight while inside of TAPTOWNE, moved closer in unison with that rival midway down the backstretch, made a bid at the half-mile pole, vied three then two wide on the far turn, dueled with the runner-up in the stretch and gamely prevailed under strong urging. TAPTOWNE went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer midway down the backstretch, made a bid at the half-mile pole, vied four then three wide on the far turn, dueled with the winner in the stretch and just missed. BOURBON COURAGE was last away, went three wide on the first turn, was urged some on the backstretch, came between horses while ridden along at the half-mile pole, raced three wide on the far turn and finished willingly to get the show. STACHYS lagged at the rear while on the inside, came off the rail late on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and improved position. SMACK RIDGE prompted the pace on the outside, drew even before the half-mile pole, vied between horses on the far turn and gave way. PROUD STRIKE went four wide on the first turn, settled near the back, raced two to three wide while urged along on the far turn, was carried out in upper stretch and also improved position. FOREST MOUSE went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn and tired. TEXAS AIR saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, was coaxed along before the half-mile pole, raced in the two path on the far turn and came up empty. SKIP THE PINOT set the pace on the inside while in hand, came under urging on the far turn, dropped out near the five-sixteenths and faded.
