FLUKE (BRZ) chased inside then outside a rival leaving the first turn and on the backstretch, went three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch and rallied under urging to wear down the runner-up late. PROUDINSKY (GER) pulled between horses early then dueled inside, inched away in the stretch and held on well but was worn down late. VICTOR'S CRY settled outside then alongside a rival or off the rail, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and just got the show. METEORE angled in and tugged a bit while stalking the pace inside, cut the corner into the stretch, bid along the rail in the drive and was outfinished. BLUE CHAGALL (FR) stalked the pace inside, steadied briefly when lacking room leaving the second turn and into the stretch, continued inside in the drive and could not summon the necessary late kick. DAKOTA PHONE a half step slow to begin, settled just off the rail, swung out a bit wide into the stretch and was outfinished. COLGAN'S CHIP four wide early, went three deep into the first turn then dueled outside the runner-up to the stretch and weakened. SKYRUSH (ARG) stalked the pace outside a rival, steadied in tight off heels into the second turn, swung out into the stretch and did not rally. JAZZMAN'S DANCE had speed between horses then stalked just off the rail, continued between foes leaving the second turn and weakened in the drive.
