Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Mar), by Freud - Maya's Note by Editor's Note. Trainer Violette, Jr. A. Richard. Bred by McMahon of Saratoga Thoroughbreds, LLC(NY). EFFIE TRINKET contently tracked the front runners while getting rated in the pocket, found room to angle outward in time for the stretch drive, split rivals at the furlong marker while taking over, albeit by only the barest of margins, sparred intensely with SALLY'S DREAM the last eighth, dug in resolutely to fend off the stiff challenge. SALLY'S DREAM raced along the outside, took the three path around the far turn, was given her cue and angled five wide into the stretch, rushed up to loom boldly with an eighth to go, battled gamely with the winner the rest of the way to the finish line, but got denied. WHOLELOTTASHAKIN unhurried in the two path and from between rivals for much of the opening three-quarters, swung four wide into the stretch, had a good finish to take the show award. FROSTY BAY raced from off the inside throughout, was taken outward departing the backstretch, left the three-eighths pole from the four path, was on the move outward once more coming into the stretch, eventually settling in the vicinity of the six path, rallied willingly for the last major check. SHAKEIRA under a firm hold by the pilot, bided time while taking the inside route, slipped slightly to the outside upon departing the second bend, was forced to idle behind a thick wall of rivals, wandered slightly more to the outside at intervals proceeding down the lane, all the while never being fully clear enough to launch a rally, finally gained sufficient room in the final seventy yards and displayed some interest. MYSTIC CITY assumed a forward position shortly after the start, was rated in the two path while prompting the pacesetter until the quarter pole, got asked for a response and gave it, fought with vigor for command from that juncture to midlane then flattened out. DREAMING OF CARA well reserved for the opening six furlongs, commenced the stretch being five wide, lacked the needed response, INIMITABLE ROMANEE brushed the gate with her left shoulder as the field was sent off and running, brought up the back of the pack while racing from off the inside, tipped into the three path coming into the five-sixteenths pole, arrived at the top of the stretch with a wall of rivals directly up ahead and as a result fanned seven into it, failed to muster up the needed response. HARBOR MIST away alertly and with no apparent mishap, quickly established control, was sent over to the rail, cut the pace, being rated and with MYSTIC prompting her, parked to the outside, continued along on the same scenario for over three-quarters, was turned loose for the drive home, got overwhelmed by a swarm of rivals before completing the ensuing furlong, backed away steadily after relinquishing the
