Bred by Nelson CANDYMAN E chased the winner towards the two path on the turn, never being close enough to apply any pressure on that foe, got asked for some run by the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home, made no progress on the leader during the ensuing furlong, began to close readily on the drifting out runner up thereafter, was allowed to move outward imitating DADS CAPS' steady migration to the middle of the strip, got the job done a few jumps before the end. DADS CAPS made light contact with BET THE POWER just after the start, responded positively to some hand urging to shake free of the others and establish control, was allowed to show the way well off the rail proceeding down the backstretch was sent much closer to the inside nearing the half mile pole, cut the pace, being rated on an open lead and from a slight distance from off the fence, got set down after the half had been completed, drifted out, particularly in the final furlong, and was reeled in a few strides before reaching the wire. NON STOP was on the track before the others, lunged up awkwardly leaving the starting gate, making contact with the nearest opponent in short order, gave chase from the two path on the turn, was already under solid encouragement taking the third one for entrance into the stretch, failed to gain ground during the initial portion of the stretch drive, altered course closer to the rail in deep stretch, reacting to the waywardness of the top twosome at this stage and made up a touch of real estate belatedly. SENSATIONAL SLAM settled along the inside route during the early going, cut the corner into the stretch, made no headway. PRAETEREO commenced the run around the turn four wide and ended it in the three path, failed to make his presence felt. BET THE POWER was pinched back to last after getting brushed

from both sides as the field was sent off and running, entered the turn three wide, swung five wide into the stretch and tired.
