NIAGARA CAUSEWAY stalked the early pace off the rail then bid outside a rival and dueled for the lead, gained the advantage nearing the half mile pole, kicked clear on the final turn and held on gamely under urging. CHURCH SERVICE a bit slow to begin, settled just off the rail then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, went three deep on the last turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished well. BIG BOOSTER chased outside a rival then three deep on the backstretch, continued alongside a foe on the final turn, came out into the stretch, rallied between horses in deep stretch and was in a bit tight between the top pair on the line. ZAPPA chased outside a rival then angled in through the stretch the first time, moved up some inside on the last turn, continued toward the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. RATHOR (IRE) chased inside then outside a rival leaving the clubhouse turn, continued between foes on the backstretch and did not rally. ROCKET LEGS settled inside then a bit off the rail, went three deep on the third turn and had little left for the stretch. PLUG ME IN took the early lead and set the pace inside, dueled inside the winner, dropped back on the final turn and gave way.
