STREAM CAT settled a bit off the rail then inside, moved up along the fence on the final turn, came out leaving that turn and into the stretch, gained the lead outside a rival past the eighth pole, kicked clear under urging and held. BIG BOOSTER unhurried while saving ground to the last turn, came out on that turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well. MEDJOOL chased inside then off the rail or outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and bested the rest. FIRE WOOD settled outside then off the rail, found the inside on the final turn, came out into the stretch, went around a foe in midstretch then lacked the needed rally inside. KIZZY'S CHAOS sent along outside rivals early, dueled alongside a foe on the first turn then stalked a bit off the rail, re-bid on the final turn to gain a clear lead, fought back in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. DYNAMALT chased the pace a bit off the rail then outside a rival into the last turn, was between foes leaving that turn and weakened. ZAPPA sent between horses early, dueled inside on the first turn then inched clear, set the pace a bit off the rail or inside, dueled briefly again on the second turn and also weakened.
