CALIBRACHOA unhurried for nearly a half, advanced on the embattled pair during the run around the bend, unasked for any serious speed, surged by the survivor of the protracted speed duel just past the eighth pole and drew off, ridden out. FASTUS CACTUS away in good order, fought against the bit but nonetheless settled near the inside before reaching the half mile pole, continued to rate kindly saving ground, angled outward in upper stretch and finished with good courage down the center of the track to garner place honors. DEPUTY DANAY used early, got hooked up in an intense duel with the top one's stable mate right from the get-go, starting showing the effects of that pace battle nearing the eighth pole, had little left to stave off the top one, succumbing with little resistance a short distance beyond that station, eventually weakening into the third slot. DAHLGREN CHAPEL four wide at the half mile pole, drifted to the six path at the top of lane and was never a factor. FLAT BOLD raced three wide and was outrun. HAVE YOU EVER gave it his all from the two path, sparring with DEPUTY DANAY throughout most of the opening half and faltered.
