DECLASSIFY had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back along the rail through the stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. CYCLOMETER dueled three deep then outside the winner, battled alongside that rival through a stiff drive and was outgamed. INDEXICAL had speed between foes to vie for command then stalked a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch and on the turn and into the stretch and bested the others. DRILL broke slowly, settled off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WINE POLICE four wide early, stalked off the rail then outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. SAHARA SKY allowed to settle just off the rail on the backstretch and turn, could not summon the needed response in the stretch.
