FAST BULLET away from the starting gate with no apparent mishap, scooted away to establish control, cut the pace, well rated in the two path, felt the pressure intensifying approaching the quarter pole, was almost a sixteenth farther down the road before getting called upon, scampered away from his stablemate to re establish a comfortable advantage, then got geared down in the final seventy yards once the outcome no longer appeared to be in doubt. JUSTIN PHILLIP contently tracked the top one while taking the inside route, was well in hand cutting the corner into the stretch, got asked for run altering course to the outside with a furlong remaining, proved no match, easily held on to place honors. LAURIE'S ROCKET was hand urged to secure a forward position, raced from between rivals on the turn, angled outward nearing the end of the bend and beat OFF THE JAK to the three path for entrance into the stretch, fell back steadily from the top twosome. OFF THE JAK received some attention with the stick on the right shoulder upon leaving the starting gate, gave chase on the winner three wide on the bend, turned for home a path wider, beaten to position by OFF THE JAK at that juncture, gave way. SAGE VALLEY off the inside, left the midway point on the turn having been asked for run, spun four wide into the stretch under a strong drive, came up empty. CAIXA ELETRONICA put to some urging nearly from the get-go, underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, was already under strong encouragement fanning five wide coming to the three-sixteenths marker, failed to make an impact.
