5 FURLONGS. (Turf) (:55) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 Twin Spires Turf Sprint S.FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$4,500 at time of entry. \$750 to pass the entry box; \$750 additional to start, with \$150,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or II stakes on the turf since October 31, allowed 3 lbs.; \$45,000 on the turf in 2015, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Twin Spires Turf Sprint will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest 2014-2015 turf earnings. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Wednesday, April 8, 2015 with 31 nominations. (Clear 69)

POWER ALERT (AUS) set the pace between horses, shook clear leaving the turn, was kept to task and held the fast closing UNDRAFTED at bay. The latter settled in hand, tucked in on the turn to save ground, split rivals entering the stretch, finished full of run but was unable to bridge the gap. SOMETHING EXTRA tracked the pace three deep, continued on well through a long drive but settled for the minor award. GOOD DEED was fractious in the gate, contended along the inside, angled out entering the stretch to make a mild bid, but flattened during the drive. BUSTER ROSE was allowed to settle, circled into the lane seven wide and was making up ground. CHANNEL MARKER was slow into stride, angled out entering the stretch, rallied between horses and improved position. FOREST ELF settled saving ground, shifted out and finished with a late gain. HEITAI prompted the pace along the hedge, but faltered entering the stretch and faded. POSITIVE SIDE was unhurried into stride, swung to the outside entering the lane and made a belated gain. JASIZZLE contended three wide to the stretch and tired.
