5 FURLONGS. (Turf) (.553) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 *BECK AUTO GROUP TURF SPRINT H.* (PLUS UP TO \$13,500 Open ATB) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start with \$100,000 guaranteed of which \$60,000 to the owner of the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$11,000 to third, \$6,000 to fourth and \$3,000 to fifth. Weights: Sunday, May 21, 2006. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred. The field will be limited to twelve starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Wednesday, May 17, 2006 with 40 nominations. (If Deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at Five Furlongs.)

SWEEPINGLY dueled on the outside, inched clear in upper stretch and held gamely under strong right hand urging. MAN OF ILLUSION (AUS) settled on the inside, was urged along on the turn, swung out at the top of the stretch and closed gradually while unable to overtake the winner. CHARMING SOCIALITE dueled on the inside, battled determinedly in the stretch but was outfinished. CRYSTAL CASTLE settled on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and failed to rally. GREGGO showed early speed then dropped back while ridden along, saved ground on the turn and lacked the needed response. ONCEAROUNDTWICE showed early speed then settled off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. SAVONAROLA (GB) showed good early speed, chased the pace down the backstretch, dropped back while off the rail on the turn and came up empty. THAT TAT was last away, raced at the back of the field while ridden along, was caught behind rivals while off the rail on the turn and was no factor. (Rail at 0 Feet)
