LOOKY YONDER outrun during the early stages while racing wide on the turn, angled over to the rail after clearing a tiring rival in upper stretch, then closed ground rapidly on the tiring pacesetter, getting up in the final yards. DREAM RUSH took control with ease, continued on the front on an open lead while racing off the inside, began shortening stride at the furlong marker and got caught in the final thirty yards.

BARONESS THATCHER raced three wide and tired. ANY LIMIT chased wide for a half and gave way. SANGRITA hit the gate at the start, and was never a threat.
